



Evan Chancellor holds the position of Assistant Professor of Music and Director of Bands at Lakeland University. He oversees the Lakeland Symphonic Band, Muskie Pride Marching Band, and LU Drumline. He teaches applied horn, conducting, and courses in music history and music education. Chancellor also serves as director of the annual Lakeland University Music Camp. He previously held faculty positions at Oklahoma Baptist University, East Central University, Oral Roberts University, and El Sistema Oklahoma City.

Chancellor is a regular extra with the Sheboygan Symphony Orchestra and also plays with the Milwaukee Philharmonic, Plymouth City Band and other local groups. Prior to arriving in Wisconsin, he was a founding member of the Frontier Brass Band and the Oklahoma Haydn Festival and also performed with the Oklahoma City Philharmonic, Tulsa Symphony, Tulsa Ballet, North Texas Chamber Orchestra, North Texas Brass Band, and the Symphony of Northwest Arkansas as well as the orchestra of the Eisenstadt Classical Music Festival.

Dr. Chancellor received the Bachelor of Music degree in Music Education from the University of North Texas. He earned the Master of Music in Horn Performance at Oklahoma City University, and Doctor of Musical Arts at the University of Oklahoma. Chancellor is a member of the National Association for Music Education, Wisconsin Music Educators Association, Collegiate Band Directors National Association, National Band Association, International Horn Society, Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia, and Kappa Kappa Psi.
