



The Sheboygan Symphony Orchestra is committed to providing the most enjoyable extraordinary experiences in as safe of an environment as possible for our community, musicians, and staff. As we continue to navigate the complexities of the COVID-19 pandemic, the following safety protocols and procedures have been implemented for the 2021-22 season:

- Face masks – worn properly covering the nose and mouth – will be **required for all patrons** while inside the Weill Center. (Face masks may be temporarily removed while consuming beverages).
- SSO musicians, staff, and volunteers will continue wearing face masks while in the Weill Center for the safety of our patrons.
- Multiple hand sanitizer stations are located throughout the Weill Center.
- Increased and enhanced cleaning between performances.
- Glass barriers have been installed in the ticket office for in-person orders. Online orders are encouraged.
- Credit card (touchless interaction for patron) and cash are accepted at concessions.
- Patrons recently exposed to someone who tested positive for COVID-19 or those feeling ill must stay home.

Those individuals that have already purchased season or individual concert tickets that no longer wish to attend can request a full refund or gift voucher for the value of the tickets for future SSO performances.
